Positions of places which do not appear on the general printed maps were estimated from speedometer readings. The estimated positions are only roughly approximate. The land is largely uncharted and the existent printed maps differ from one another. The principal maps used in working out the estimated coordinates were:

Bechuanaland Protectorate, Ordinance Survey Office,
Southampton, 1935.

South Africa and Madagascar, Bartholomew and Son,
Ltd., Edinburgh, 1959.

Note on variant spellings:

The place names vary on the printed maps and in the literature, as well as in the notes of the Marshall Expedition members. Bushman names and words present special difficulties and extreme variations in the rendering of Bushman sounds into alphabetical symbols and/or phonetic symbols appear among the linguists themselves as well as in the literature on Bushmen in general. Lorna Marshall would like to defer to someone better qualified in linguistics than she is, but to avoid confusion in her own notes and records and in view of the fact that she has already published using certain forms, she feels she must hold more or less to her own renditions.

The rendering of the name !Kung (Lorna Marshall's choice of spelling) is a case in point. !Kung refers to a group of Bushmen and their language, which has four clicks and is classified by Dorothea Bleek in A Bushman Dictionary as Northern Group II. Several variant spellings follow:

1. The !Kung of the Nyae Nyae region in S.W.A. and B.P. call themselves ju /ōasi. The Bushmen to the south of them, namely Naron, Tsaukwe and Makaukau (Auen) also use this designation for them. The spelling dzu/oasi is Nicholas England's. Professor L. F. Maingard in "Three Bushman Languages" (African Studies, 16/1, 1957, 37-71) renders the words dzu/?oa:si. Both were members of one or another of the Marshall expeditions. Passarge spells the phrase Ssu² gnassi and Dorothea Bleek, zu/nwasi. Ju means person or people; si at the end of a word is the plural sign. We never succeeded in finding an exact meaning for /ōa. One interpreter thought it meant clean and empty as a pot might be clean and empty - undefiled. Elizabeth Marshall Thomas paraphrases it as "harmless" in her title, The Harmless People, and said the word suggested a meaning to her like "just" in "just ourselves." Dole is the opposite of /ōa. Dole means both "strange" and "harmful", which are synonyms to the !Kung. (See Lorna Marshall, "Marriage Among !Kung Bushmen," Africa, vol. xxix, no. 4, Oct., 1959, p. 337.)

2. !Kõ is the spelling given by L. F. Maingard to the Bushmen south of Okwa whose language has five clicks instead of the four of the northern groups. (See "Three Bushman Languages", African Studies, 16/1, 1957, 37-71.) Magon is the name for these Bushmen which appears on the 1935 Ordinance Survey map and which we heard locally. !Kxõ is the spelling adopted by Nicholas England.
