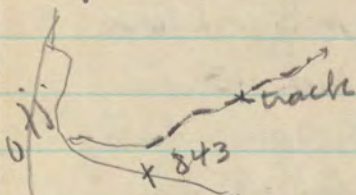

live in a wufo less than a mile from camp. West. They are !Kung. They are 20± both born there. Makeongo has worked on farms near Outjo - 2 years has been back here 2 yrs. He was well there - Christian was farmer's name. Married to girl born in same wufo. There is another wufo 4 mi E. of here. He has been to Bandua this year with J. Marie. He usually goes to visit his relatives there. His father's name was Chikussi - another black name. They give their children black names often and then say there are Bushman names. Makeongo's brother who lives E. village has been in mines. They go to the missions and are recruited there. They talk to the Foreman (black) who takes them to the trucks. They are taken to Rumbi & then back

His Bro. went by air. Has been back here about a month. In mines 2 rains. Liked '88. Mak. is too young but when old enough he plans to go. Bro ~~put~~ loaded ~~two~~ rocks in little cars. Bro knew 2 other Bushmen in the mines who did some work. Not relatives. They were gone 2 yrs. Bro. brought \$5 back with him and many clothes. Mak. didn't see the money. just heard about '88.

In mines he spoke Sapa Sapa. Lived in same house with black people. There is ^{black} one man here who was in same mine. He had been in the mines before. Mak. thinks work on farms about same as in mines. He thinks he will go back maybe. Wants to go to different farm. The man he worked for before was too troublesome, he was hitting him. Mak. was doing housework and milking cows. Had notion of making. He likes milk. Had all he wanted. Farmer made

cream - He had skin milk. There were six
other Bushmen on the farm - different language
they had come from West - far. They had wives
Male was married a year ago. He knew no
other Bushmen there. He went to Audara -
the black foreman there who gave him a note
he gave to truck driver who took him to
Lumbi. He told recruiter he wanted to go
to Insootfontein to work for anyone. He
didn't care where. He got £5 for 3 mos
also some clothes. He brought no money back.
Bought shoes, shorts, hat & blanket.
That was all he bought. He received ^{from the farm} £3,¹
when he left. WMA didn't give him any
when he got off truck. WMA put him off at
Audara. Trucks came there at night
didn't stop at Nyangana.

U.S. Army to the Smithsonian
Institution for the specific
purpose of research amongst
the Bushmen of ~~this territory~~.
The use of the trucks was
offered to the Dutel Refound

Church for mission work
amongst the Bushmen in
the Nyae Nyae Area. Unfortunately
that church found itself
unable to undertake this
mission work, and I have
now offered these trucks to
the Bushman Affairs
Commissioner for use amongst
the Bushmen in that area.

This offer has been accepted
and I have handed over
the trucks in question to
the Bantu Affairs Department
Windhoek in furtherance
of our work. I shall
~~be~~ probably return next year
for further research and
would then again make use

of the trucks. In these
circumstances I shall be
grateful if further permission
to keep the trucks in the
territory against the depots
could be granted.
