I will keep you advised.

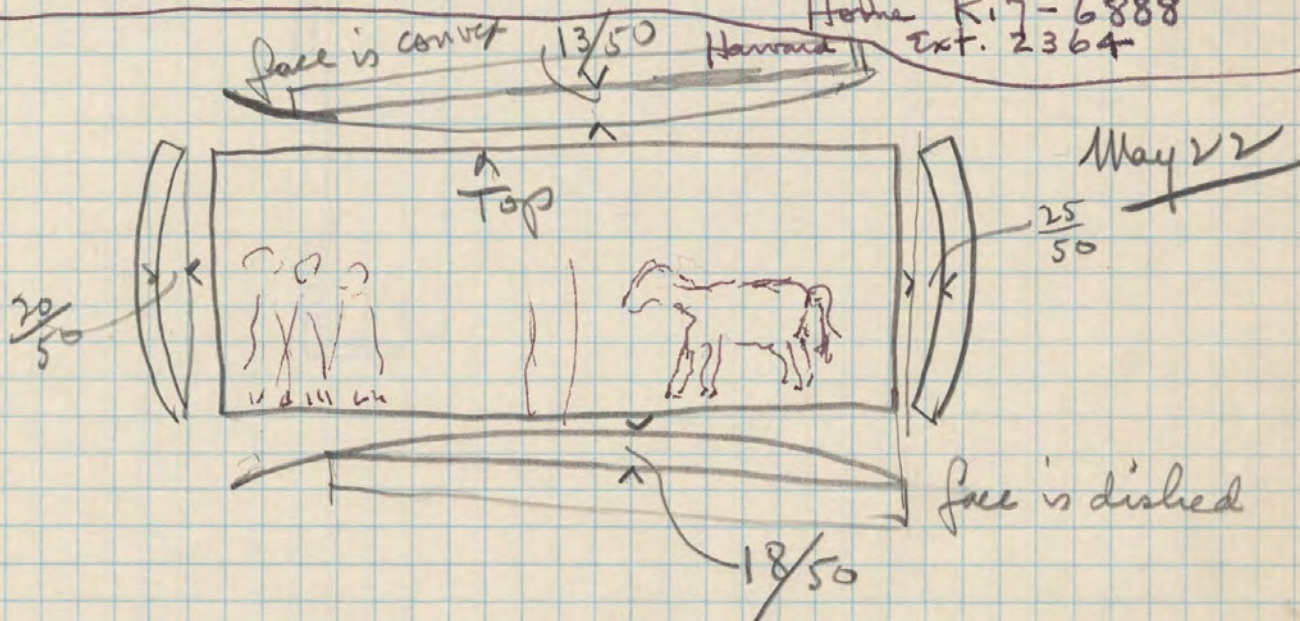
