A woman here got a message brought by the people who came today from Nama with /Qui and De|ai, that a wama^{*} was bitten by a puff adder and died. (On later interview it was clarified that it had been a boy who was bitten, a boy about the age of Gao medidine's son Gaishay.) The boy was buried yesterday, i.e. July 17. The relative here is /Gam the mother of Bo's wife, Bau.

She is walking in the beld between the waterhold and the werft, wailing and crying out "aie ya, aie ya" 9 (mother. mother). She came eventually to sit beside Kho//o's fire where she sobbed and wiped her tears but did not wail anu more.

Gao Helmet told me about this. He said that there are few Bushmen and that if one dies they feel the loss terribly. Gao thinks that among blacks and whites of whom there are so, many the grief at the loss of one may not be so great.

(Original note said, "Gao thinks people who are many, the non-Bushmen- don't care so much if someone dies because why they are many".)

Story of Recording

pm June 18 1953

Hans Ernst - Herin came over with the truck about 4:30, to take wryt sounds in general.

Hans fell off the truck catching his ring and hanging by it. It cut deeply into his hand. After he recovered from feeling faint from shock, we proceeded. Nothing much was going on. We were thinking where best to put the miks when we heard a truck. Philip ran over to say visitors had arrived. There was a hub bub of talk which we recorded. A number of people went back with Laurens to see who came. We got conversation and singing and little boys bawling as autos then Kkanna, Igasa's sister an Inp ran back and told the group that Europeans had come. She said they had already castrated the people in Sam Angai gai and had come here to castrate some men there. She pointed out which ones were to be castrated and which not. There was an uproar of laughter - recorded.

I had just gathered up my things to go back to see the guests, when along they came 2 young men Mr. Preller - another.

The Bushmen were silent - drew into groups did not come forward to greet the guests. Recorded. I am sitting now in + Tomas group the young men went to the pau. We feel more possessive about this country and our Bushmen than we have any right to. Blast these visitors!

Phillips regards the guests with suspicion. He says they have no dogs with them. They must be crazy. Who gets water? He never saw European travel without dogs here.

Heine and Hans regard them with suspicion. They say they are after diamonds, but do not know whether they are proper people or not.

My prediction is that one truck will arrive back here, the other having broken down. We shall have to go to Toe^o it in.

Mr. Preller said he went to the Ah Kas last year by way of Reuntu! There is something very queer about this. He did not come by any of our trails, and there is no way except through is nor via Tsau. and there is no other way except through brush along the border which is preposterous. over

P.M. Friday June 27 1953

#Goma's Skern burned about 3 in the afternoon. I was asleep Lawrence was filming film. John was at the weft. By the time we got there the skern was nothing but smoking ash and Igam was sitting almost in tears looking in the ashes for her beads. The bag in which she had her three beautiful head bands and the yards of ostrich egg shell beads was burned. The industry of more than a year, her wealth. They had some blankets #Goma's quiver & bow his shirt & pants and a Karoo. All else was burned. The greatest loss beside the beads was the carrying bags I suppose.

The fire had been Kheanlla's doing. #Goma's & Igam's granddaughter of two. #Goma was at Gao's skern, Igam was across the weft. #Nisa was not watching her daughter who was playing at #Goma's fire. She got her stomach burned.

John took 100 feet of film. We got a recording of the lull but of speech. What was being said was the accusations of the women blaming the men for not saving more and the men saying what they had seen and that they had been in various places when the fire started. Kheanlla wife of Gao
