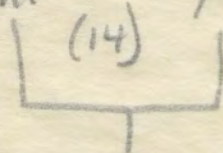
This is a young men's stem. The young men are shown with their parents. Apparently Ku/Noa lives here as well as (16) which is another young men's stem.
