Tsam^{gao} + Qui took me down to the pan to get salt. They each had a can. went first to the water hole and filled the can with water, then took it 1/8 (about) mile out onto the pan. Tsam^{gao} broke the crust with his foot, tasted the sand - no good - he went on, found where a little buck had broken the crust - tasted there, no good - went on to where the sand tasted salty. Then he filled his can full of water with the sand, reaching under the crust allways, taking sand no deeper than 4 inches, until the can was full. Then he made mud pies out of the sand - 3 large round balls ^{one small one}. Where the mud was too wet he sprinkled more sand over it until it was of the right consistancy. When the mud balls were finished he spread a thick pad of grass, put them on it - left them to dry. This was first thing in the morning. In the afternoon he came back, gathered the mud balls that were by now nearly dry and brought them home. Unfortunately they got rained on, it will have to be done over.
